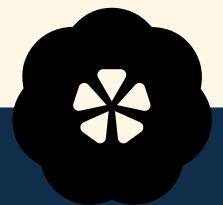
G.S. LOHIA COLLEGE

FACULTY SPOTLIGHT

The Right to Information (RTI) gives citizens the authority to access detailed information regarding government policies, actions, and financial dealings. By ensuring access to information, RTI encourages public participation in governance and strengthens citizens' administrative power. Sweden was the first country to introduce freedom of information in 1766, followed later by countries such as Finland (1959), the United States (1966), Ireland (1997), and South Africa (2000).

In India, the Right to Information Bill was passed on 11 May 2005 and came into effect on 12 October 2005. It is considered a landmark reform in Indian administration. Under the RTI Act, information includes documents, emails, notices, contracts, reports, newspapers, samples, and other records, all of which must be made easily accessible to the public.

The Act mandates the appointment of Public Information Officers in all government offices to supply information to citizens who request it. To oversee the implementation of the Act, the Central Government established the Central Information Commission through an official notification. The Commission consists of a Chief Information Commissioner and up to ten Information Commissioners, appointed by the President of India on the recommendation of a selection committee led by the Prime Minister.

Initially, the term of the Chief Information Commissioner was fixed at five years, but it has now been reduced to three years for the Chief and other Commissioners. The Act also provides for the establishment of State Information Commissions in every state.

The main objective of the RTI Act is to make citizens aware of how the government actually functions. It seeks to promote transparency, reduce corruption, and ensure good governance. The Act has played a crucial role in making the Indian administration more accountable, transparent, and democratic. It has strengthened public trust and improved efficiency by ensuring timely implementation of government work. Consequently, the Right to Information Act remains highly relevant today, with its importance continuing to grow in India and across the world.

NEPAL'S GEN-Z REVOLUTION: A DIGITAL SPARK IGNITES A POLITICAL FIRESTORM

Kathmandu – What began as a protest against a sweeping social media ban has erupted into one of the most dramatic youth-led uprisings in Nepal's recent history. The "Gen-Z Revolution," as it is now widely called, has toppled Prime Minister K.P. Sharma Oli and signaled the arrival of a restless new generation determined to reshape the country's political landscape.

The Trigger: Ban on Digital Lifelines :

Earlier this month, the Oli government announced a ban on 26 popular social media platforms, including Facebook, Instagram, WhatsApp, YouTube, and X. Officials claimed that the companies had failed to register locally and appoint grievance officers. But for Nepal's digitally native youth, the ban was the last straw. To them, these platforms were not just entertainment—they were spaces of self-expression, connection, and dissent. The blackout was seen as an attack on their freedom, compounding long-standing frustrations with corruption, nepotism, unemployment, and political instability.

From Screens to Streets :

Protests first erupted in Kathmandu but quickly spread across the nation. Young people organized using

encrypted apps and gaming platforms like Discord and Telegram, bypassing official restrictions. Within days, crowds swelled, slogans echoed, and clashes with security forces turned deadly. Government offices, political party headquarters, and even the homes of senior leaders were targeted. Hashtags like NepoKids captured public anger over elite privilege, while memes and reels fueled momentum. The intensity of the demonstrations proved overwhelming. Facing mounting casualties and international concern, Prime Minister Oli resigned, ending his turbulent tenure.

A Leaderless, Decentralized Movement :

Unlike traditional protests driven by political parties, the Gen-Z Revolution emerged as a largely leaderless uprising. Mobilization was horizontal, spontaneous, and creative. Viral videos, symbolic imagery, and online humor gave the movement a distinct character, reflecting the cultural fluency of a generation raised online. Observers note that this horizontal model both strengthens the movement—making it harder to suppress—and raises questions about its long-term direction.

Aftermath and Interim Leadership

In the wake of the turmoil, former Chief Justice Sushila Karki was appointed interim Prime Minister.

Widely respected for her integrity, she has pledged to heal the nation's wounds and address youth grievances. The government has declared a day of mourning for those killed in the protests and announced compensation for victims' families.

Beyond the Ban: What Gen Z Wants :

While the social media ban sparked the uprising, the demands of Nepal's youth run deeper. They are calling for:

- * Transparent and accountable governance
- * Economic opportunities to curb mass migration for work
- * Policies to tackle corruption and nepotism
- * Stronger safeguards for digital rights and freedom of expression

The Road Ahead :

The Gen-Z Revolution has demonstrated the power of a connected, impatient, and idealistic generation. Yet the challenges ahead remain formidable. Sustaining reforms, preventing political co-optation, and addressing structural economic constraints will test Nepal's institutions. Still, the message is clear: Nepal's young people are no longer content to be spectators. They are prepared to lead, protest, and demand accountability. Their revolution has already changed the political order—and may yet redefine the country's future.
